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It is to inform that, the Union Ministry of Health and Family Welfare has launched a Kayakalp Initiative on 15th Nov 2015. Kayakalp programme an cash award to the Public Health facilities - Swachh Bharath Abhiyan/Swachhata Hospitals to promote 'Swachhta/cleanliness' in public health facilities for improvement of Hospital environments, Hygiene promotion, patient safety and health outcomes which contribute to the goal of Swachh Bharat Abhiyan (Kayakalp) by using the checklists on 6 parameters like i. Hospital/Facility Upkeep ii. Sanitation and hygiene iii. Waste Management iv. Infection control. V. Support Services & vi. Hygiene Promotion. This initiation of implementation for the FY 2017-18 will be taken up to UPHCs with the support of Quality Assurance team.


It is to inform that, the Kayakalp initiative based on the objective assessment criteria, and cash award to the best performing facilities for improvement of Hospital environments, Hygiene promotion, Cleanliness and infection control Practices, patient safety and health outcomes which contribute to the goal of Swachh Bharat Abhiyan (Kayakalp). Kayakalp implementation for the financial year 2017-18, will be extended to all UPHCs in the State of Telangana. Total UPHCs - 64, PHCs - 683, CHC – 98, AHs – 30 and DHs – 6, total number of facilities in the state of Telangana – 881.
