Hospital/Facility Upkeep ii. Sanitation and hygiene iii. Waste Management iv. Infection control. V. Support Services & vi. Hygiene Promotion. This initiation of implementation for the FY 2017-18 will be taken up to UPHCs with the support of Quality Assurance team.

It is to inform that, the Kayakalp initiative based on the objective assessment criteria, and cash award to the best performing facilities for improvement of Hospital environments, Hygiene promotion, Cleanliness and infection control Practices, patient safety and health outcomes which contribute to the goal of Swachh Bharat Abhiyan (Kayakalp).
